Workshop is inclusive for all children

The Cerebral Palsy League is hosting a free workshop next Saturday which aims to build inclusive communities across the Darling Downs.

According to social inclusion expert and Perth based psychologist, Associate Professor Bob Jackson, children who learn to be inclusive in their school years will go on to be more socially inclusive as adults, and help create a more inclusive society.

A recent study showed there was a positive difference between the attitudes of a group of children who had had a child with a disability in their pre-school for just one year, versus a group of other children who had not.

“Engaging in Life” will explore how families can build a full life for their child and how local communities can be inclusion.

“People with a disability are told that an ordinary life is not possible for them while every other person in society is able to have one,” Associate Professor Jackson said.

Engaging in Life will be held at the Toowoomba City Golf Club on May 7 from 9.30am-3pm.
